FIRST COAST METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION LIST OF PRIORITY PROJECTS

The submittal of the First Coast Metropolitan Planning Organization (First Coast MPO) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Fiscal Years 2008/2009 through 2012/2013 begins with preparing a "List of Priority Projects" to be used in developing the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) Tentative Work Program for Fiscal Years 2008/2009 through 2012/2013. The "List of Priority Projects" identifies potential projects to be funded in the new fifth year (2012/2013) of the FDOT Work Program. However, by creating the Strategic Intermodal System (SIS) and the Transportation Regional Incentive Program (TRIP) in the State of Florida, the "List of Priority Projects" now includes potential projects to be funded in other years of the FDOT Work Program under the SIS and TRIP programs. The "List of Priority Projects" includes a prioritized listing of state highway, mass transit, aviation, intermodal and enhancement projects and was approved by the First Coast MPO Board August 9, 2007.

All highway projects are included in the First Coast MPO 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan Update and have been determined to be conforming and are consistent with the requirements of the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990 (CAAA) and 40 Code of Federal Regulations Part 51 - "Criteria and Procedures for Determining Conformity."

The First Coast MPO expects all projects currently programmed in the FDOT Work Program to advance to the next phase of development. This will ensure that implementing the 3-C planning process (continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive) in the First Coast MPO area is being carried out, as required by federal and state statutes. If FDOT cannot complete the programmed phase and advance the project to the next logical phase, it is incumbent upon the agency to provide an explanation to the First Coast MPO.

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2007 LIST OF PRIORITY PROJECTS PROCESS

1) Develop List of Candidate Projects (May - June)

- a) A list of candidate projects was developed from the following:
 - Projects in the previous year List of Priority Projects not funded through construction.
 - Local County/City submittals within the First Coast MPO area
 - Local Port and Transit Authority submittals within the First Coast MPO area
 - Adopted Long Range Transportation Plan
 - Congestion Management System Plan
 - Concurrency Management Systems
 - Public Input
- b) Projects submitted were reviewed by First Coast MPO Staff using the following criteria:
 - Project must be within the First Coast MPO area.
 - Capacity projects must be in the Cost Feasible List of the Adopted Long Range Transportation Plan unless proposed for PD&E Study only.

2) Ranking the List of Candidate Projects (July)

- a) MPO Staff developed a preliminary List of Priority Projects to submit to the TCC, CAC and MPO Board for review and approval.
- b) Mass transit, port, and aviation projects were prioritized by the submitting agency and forwarded to the MPO for inclusion in the LOPP Document.

3) Submitting the List of Priority Projects (August)

Following First Coast MPO approval, the List of Priority Projects was submitted to the FDOT for use in developing the Five Year Tentative Work Program.
